

Pear **ABATE FETEL**



Tree: variety with upright habit and medium-low vigour.

Good direct grafting and intergraft compatibility with quince.

Bears fruit early, with constant productivity if properly pruned.

Bears fruit mainly on spurs and twoyear-old branches.

Fruit: large size, long and slender in shape.

Yellow-green skin with rust-coloured areas of varying size and red blushing in the areas most exposed to the sun.

Fine, white, juicy, aromatic pulp with an excellent flavour.

Picking season: 25 days after Williams B.C.
