

Pear **SANTA MARIA**



Tree: high vigour. Excellent grafting compatibility with quince.

Bears fruit quickly, with high productivity. Fruit grows on both one-year-old and two-year-old branches.

Fruit: medium-large in size, pyriform in shape. Yellow skin with small, light green freckles and red blushing in the areas most exposed to the sun.

Firm, white, juicy, creamy pulp when fully ripe.

Picking season: 15 days before Williams B.C.
