Tree: high vigour; very early bearing; high and constant cropping.

Blossoming time: early-season, usually 3-4 days pre B.Burlat; self-fertile (S3S4').

Fruits: large size (prevailing caliber 30-32 mm); heart-shaped and symmetrical; shiny, purplish red, overall skin colouring (4 on CTIFL colour code) turning to bright dark red at an advanced ripening stage (6 CTIFL on CTIFL colour code); firm, well-textured.

Harvesting season: medium-early and regular; it starts 10-12 days post B.Burlat.
