Plant: plant with high chill requirement, medium-high vigor and average foliage density. Rustic plant, with good tolerance to both radical and leaves diseases. Very high productivity.

Long lasting harvest characterized by two contiguous blooms.

Flowers: within the foliage, medium size, rich in pollen and of very easy pollination.

Blossoming time: early and continuous throughout the season.

Fruits: short heart-shaped, with medium sized calyx, large berries. Fruit color uniformly bright red; red pulp, good texture and firmness. The flavor is excellent, very fragrant with hints of wild strawberry. One of the best varieties for those who love aromatic strawberries. Its exceptional organoleptic characteristics make this fruit ideal for P. Y. O., direct sales and quality pastry.

Harvesting time: early, harvest season begins at about the same time as Clery* but lasts much longer.
