

## Strawberry NABILA\*



Plant: with low chill requirement, suitable for Mediterranean climates. Variety of medium-high vigor, with medium foliage density, semi-upright habit. Rustic plant, with remarkable tolerance to both radical and leaves diseases. Robust and efficient root system; the plant has good adaptability to tired soil; generally it does not require a soil disinfection. Thanks to its vigor and hardiness it is very suitable for the stubble crop production and requires moderate nutritional supplements. Productivity is very high, higher than standard varieties. Harvest period is prolonged and constant. It is suitable both as fresh plant and as cold-stored plant, the latter assuring an excellent autumn harvest.

Flowers: large size, very rich in pollen, quick and efficient pollination even in adverse conditions such as low temperature, high humidity and low light. Flowers are slightly above the foliage, mostly sustained by single stems.

Blossoming time: very early and long lasting.

Fruits: regular conical shape, with medium sized calyx; large bright red berries, very attractive colour, that does not darken even at advanced ripening. Uniform red coloured pulp, firm and resistant to handling. Taste is very pleasant and sweet. Fruit size and plant structure make picking easy, allowing sensible cost savings.

Harvesting time: very early, start in the season with strong quantity proceeding more regularly for a long period during the season.
