

## ● Apple **BUCKEYE® GALA SIMMONS<sup>(PBR)</sup>** ●



**Tree:** good initial vigour that normalises when it enters into full production. High and constant productivity.

**Fruit:** very attractive. Buckeye® Gala Simmons<sup>(PBR)</sup> is the red mutation of the Imperial Gala, and is characterised by strong and early colour development. It has a bright red colour with washed-out streaks on the entire surface of the fruit and a distinct star-shaped lenticel that increases the beauty of the skin.

Early colour development allows harvesting the fruit at the right level of ripeness, with consequent reduction in the number of passages and risk of splitting, giving this variety excellent preservation qualities. The flesh is typical of the Gala, crispy, with a strong aroma and sweet taste.

**Harvest time:** 25 days before Golden Delicious cl.B. In line with other Gala clones, but its early colouring allows picking a high percentage of fruits in the first step.

This characteristic makes the Buckeye® Gala Simmons<sup>(PBR)</sup> less susceptible to cracking and over-ripening, with excellent preservation qualities.
