Tree: upright habit and medium-high vigour. Good grafting compatibility with quince.

Bears fruit very early. Medium-high, constant productivity.

Bears fruit on both one-year-old and two-year-old branches.

Fruit: medium-large in size, which makes it very interesting given the early picking season.

Elongated, slender shape. Yellow-green skin with red blushing over 20-30% of the surface; large, clearly visible freckles.

Medium-fine, juicy, aromatic pulp with an excellent flavour.

Picking season: 22 days before Williams B.C.
