

Pear **CONFERENCE**



Tree: medium-low vigour. Good grafting compatibility with quince.

Bears fruit early. High, constant productivity, thanks to parthenocarpy.

Fruit: medium-large in size with proper pruning. Elongated, slender shape with thick, short, woody stem.

Light green skin with large rusty areas. White, sweet, creamy, aromatic pulp.



Picking season: 10 days after Williams B.C.
